

River City Ribs



Servings: 8–10 | Challenge Level: Easy

“We live by the Missouri River, and our historic town is often referred to as the ‘River City’. Jack McCall was tried and hung in Yankton in 1877 for shooting Wild Bill Hickok. Also, Lewis and Clark met near here with the Yankton Sioux Tribe in August 1804 on their way through to North Dakota.”

Preparation at Camp:

1. Mix Coca-Cola and barbeque sauce together in Dutch oven.
2. Separate ribs between the bones and place in barbeque sauce.
3. Place 15 briquettes under the oven and 10 coals on the lid. Simmer for 1½ hours or until meat is tender, refreshing coals as required.

Required Equipment:

12-inch Dutch oven

¾ can Coca-Cola (do not use diet soda)

5 (18-ounce) jars Sweet Baby James barbeque sauce

3 racks baby back ribs
